About PACAC Camp College 2017

Camp College 2017 is a real life residential college experience exposing rising high school juniors and seniors to a comprehensive college prep curriculum over the course of three days and two nights. During the program students are immersed in an array of meaningful experiences to expose them to the nuances of the college selection and application process, including but not limited to; scholarships and financial aid, dorm life, meeting admissions representatives, using your guidance counselor effectively, etc. The program is open to 120 eligible students from across the state of Pennsylvania (60 at each site).

In 2017, PACAC will be offering 2 sites to better accommodate students from both sides of the state.

- Camp College West, Hosted by Allegheny College
 - o Program Dates: Tuesday, July 18th Thursday, July 20th
- Camp College East, Hosted by Albright College
 - o Program Dates: Tuesday, July 25th-Thursday, July 27th

The program is designed to assist students who have limited access to college culture, but with the desire to attain a post-secondary degree. Throughout the program there will be many large and small group sessions facilitated by volunteer mentors with a passion for college access for all! Mentors/Chaperones will drive the success of the program as students will have a semi personal mentor throughout the program to answer questions and gain useful information about college. Mentor/Chaperones also play a key roll in activities during the three day program.

Mentor/Chaperone Responsibilities

- Must stay for the entirety of the program, including overnight in the residence halls. (All chaperones will be given a single room.)
- Participate in mentor training
- Lead small group sessions and discussions throughout the duration of the program
- Supervise students during all events (this includes daily large group general sessions and small group meetings.)
- Ensure that students are attending the selected workshops and remain on schedule
- Monitor student activity in residence halls
- And many more fun duties as assigned
