Camp College 2016 is a residential college experience exposing rising high school juniors and seniors to a comprehensive college prep curriculum over the course of three days and two nights on the campus of Albright College in Reading, Pa. The program will take place from Tuesday July 26th – Thursday July 28th. During the program students are immersed in an array of meaningful experiences to expose them to the nuances of the college selection and application process, including but not limited to; scholarships and financial aid, dorm life, meeting admissions representatives, using your guidance counselor effectively, etc. The program is open to 60 eligible students from across the state of Pennsylvania.

Eligibility

Eligible students for Camp College will:

- Be a member of the Class of 2017 or 2018 (during the summer of 2016 be a rising junior or senior)
- Minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA
- Attend a Pennsylvania high school
- Be motivated to attend college after high school

Application Process

Applicants must follow this process in order to be considered:

- Complete the entire student application and have your parent/guardian sign where needed.
- Please type or print neatly using black ink.
- Please include your name and high school at the top of each application page
- Complete the student essay.
- Include a current copy of your high school transcript.
- Include a letter of recommendation from one of the following:
 - Your high school counselor
 - o Current teacher
 - Supervisor or mentor from a community based organization
